# The Timeline

March 2005 - The South West Brunswick and St. Andrew's Uniting Church congregations merged to become the Brunswick Uniting Church

May 2005 - Began process of discernment and visioning with Randall Lindstrom, which led to the "5 Concept Statements" document (incorporating Values, Treasures and Needs) July 2006 - Congregation adopted "Concept Plan" for whole site

2006-2007 - Lots of work on design, costings, and financing questions

February 2008 - Scope of work and estimated costing took shape

November 2008 - Congregation approved broad scope of works and funding model

2009 - Further revisions of scope/design, negotiations for heritage and planning permits, and detailed drawings/documentation

March 2010 - Signed contract with Leeda

**April 2010 - Works commenced on the hall** 

May 2010 - Pipe organ removed, works on the hall completed, congregation began worshipping in the hall, works commenced in the Olive Way and Worship space June 2010 - Pews & flooring removed, excavation of outside commenced

July 2010 - Roof reinstated on Olive Way, work on new entrance & garden beds commenced

August 2010 - Stain glass windows returned, work on AV system & paving commenced

September 2010 - Carpets laid, pews & flooring completed in worship space 26<sup>th</sup> September - Returned to the Worship Space, Olive Way reopened October 2010 - Work on the ramp almost completed, lots of finishing touches 27th October - Final Site meeting 30th October - Planting Bee

**November 2010 - Project substantially completed** 

Still to come - New signage, including recognition of Wurundjeri people, correction of some minor defects






The Building Project started in April and continued into May with work on the hall and in particular the installation of the Operable Wall. The new coat of paint looks just fantastic!! While this was happening the pipe organ was removed. It was quite a sight seeing pieces of the organ spread all over the worship space.

On **Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> May** we participated in a transition liturgy at the end of worship. The whole congregation followed a procession of the symbols of worship from the worship space and into the not quite finished hall. Once gathered in the hall Ray then reverently and deliberately placed each of the symbols of worship on a covered work bench, each action was accompanied by words which reminded us of what the symbols mean and who we are as a people of God.

The builders wasted no time in the process of 'gutting' the church in the following week. The Olive Way was moved into the west end of the hall during the week and on Saturday 22nd May a hard working group of people gathered to move the last remaining pieces of furniture, music & sound equipment and other assorted bits & pieces from the worship space and into the hall. We then set up the hall ready for worship on Pentecost Sunday.

During the building works we have enjoyed Morning Tea on the lawn. Many people have commented on the difference in the way we gather, talk and interact on the lawn compared to being inside the hall. We hope to continue sharing morning tea in the garden as long as the weather allows.







<u>Olive Way</u> - removal of the roof over the Olive Way & preparations for the new extended roof, the Olive Way settling into the temporary space at the west end of the hall.



<u>Worship Space</u> - removal of pews and old flooring, installment of flooring & preparations for painting, installation of wiring for the two screens.

Last Sunday the Renewal committee met to discuss carpet colours and other exciting matters. The stain glass windows are almost ready for installation, a process that will take a month to complete.



Hall - working out how the heating & lighting currently works in the hall (to be

completed when there is a roof over the Olive Way), completion of the Operable Wall, flooding into the hall (unfortunately) during a particularly heavy downpour.

Exterior excavation around the outside of the site including lifting up the bluestone, delivery of a large storage container, preparations for the footings for the new entrance, a real estate board is also up to let people know we are still open for worship.










<u>Olive Way</u> - Entrances almost ready for use.
