About the camp

Here's a chance to relax, get to know each other better, learn from each other, and simply "be" together.

The camp is once again at our old favourite, Adekate Forest Lodge – on the road from Dean to Creswick, about 1.5 hours drive from Brunswick.

Adekate Lodge is a Uniting Church campsite, with accommodation in cabins surrounded by beautiful native bushland. There are individual cabins for families, as well as shared cabins, and shared bathrooms (with locked cubicle showers). All rooms are heated.

The camp is well equipped with tennis court, recreation room, play areas, an oval and bushwalking tracks. The archery equipment is always popular too.

All meals are provided from Friday (light supper) to Sunday lunch, but please bring something to share for morning and afternoon teas.



What to bring

- Sheets/doona/sleeping bag
- Pillow & pillowcase – no longer supplied by Adekate
- Toiletries, towel & also tea towels
- Warm clothes, including all-weather walking gear
- Board games, cards, instruments, books
