Improving the comfort of your home and saving you money

Is your home cold and uncomfortable during the winter and hot and uncomfortable in the summer?

Are you spending a lot on heating or cooling your home?

Would you like to speak to someone about changes to your home so that you can be more comfortable in your home and don't have to spend so much on heating and cooling bills?

Earthworker Smart Energy Cooperative is leading a program to make homes like yours more comfortable in the winter and summer months and reduces your energy costs.

What we do: No-cost energy audits and retrofits of low-income households

- We conduct an audit and assessment of your home to identify what could be done to make your home more comfortable to live in during the winter and summer months.
- We draught proof gaps in floors, ceilings, walls, windows, doors and unused chimneys
- We replace ceiling extractions fans and manhole covers
- We seal wall vents
- We supply evaporative cooling vent covers for wintertime use
- We insulate external copper hot water piping
- We assist with writing and issuing notices to the landlord.

Are you eligible?

If you live in social housing or you rent or own a home and are a low income household, then you could be eligible.

What does it cost?

If you are eligible it is no cost to you or your landlord to participate.

How to get involved:

Register your interest before the end of March 2022. We will support you to contact your landlord for permission to make changes.
