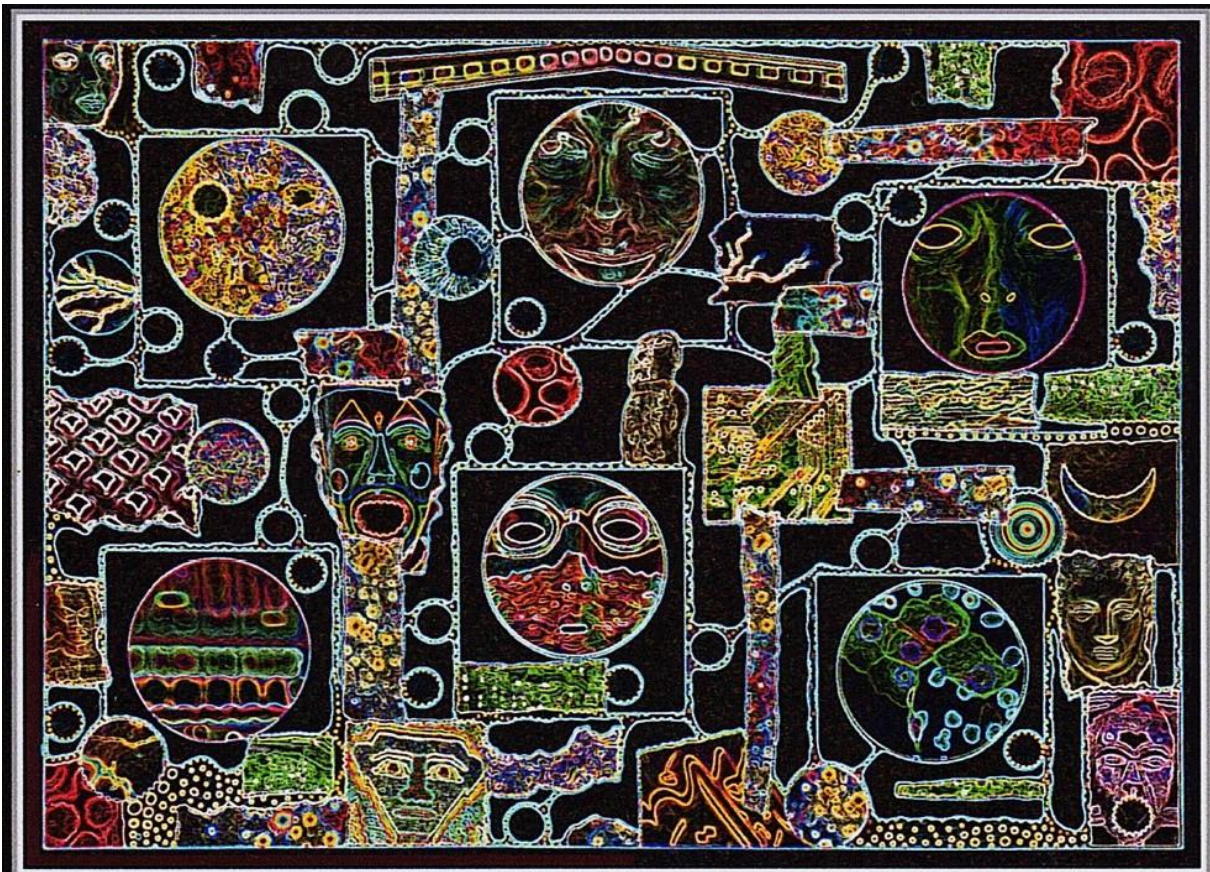


Image: 'Electric Fluorescent Glow' by Paul
